

## AirRail, a single electronic ticket for your train and flight reservations

The network of high-speed trains is constantly expanding and ensures that large European cities are increasingly well connected. Airlines often also offer high-speed train journeys to connect intercontinental flights in major European airports.

Thanks to AirRail you can, from wherever in the world, book your flight and train tickets for Thalys and InterCity (IC) trains between Belgium and the Netherlands and all this in one go!

### Travelling from/to Belgium via Amsterdam Airport Schiphol



You can catch any IC train on the day mentioned on your ticket. Seat reservation is not available. You may occupy a vacant seat in the appropriate class as indicated on your ticket.

Thalys trains connect Brussels-Midi and Antwerp-Central with Amsterdam Airport Schiphol. You can only travel between the train stations and on the service indicated on your e-ticket. Your seat reservation is included.

### How to receive your train ticket?

Earliest 72 hours before train departure, you will have to check in via [check-in.accessrail.com](http://check-in.accessrail.com) to print your train ticket. Keep your reservation number (PNR locator) or e-ticket number handy to facilitate check-in. This is NOT applicable for KLM-travellers.

If you travel with KLM you will be booked on the actual Thalys service. Earliest 4 hours before departure, you must exchange your e-ticket for a Thalys ticket from the "International Ticket" counter at one of the following stations: Brussels-Midi, Antwerp-Central or Amsterdam Airport Schiphol.

### IMPORTANT

- After you have exchanged your e-ticket for a train ticket, the ticket cannot be changed or cancelled.
- Make sure you keep your train ticket; the barcode on the ticket opens the gates on the platform to leave.
- In case of disruptions, please contact your travel agency or airline.
